According to Almond and Verba, Political culture is subdivided into three categories.

1) Parochial culture: this culture was meant a system in which there was low cognition of political objects. The people by and large have no awareness of national political system. Peoples are only diffused politico-economic and religious links of the people.

Still another determinant of Political culture is Socio-economic structure. A predominantly urban industrialised society is a more complex society, putting a premium on rapid communications as compared with a rural society which is not geared to changes and is also non-innovative. Similarly states with predominantly peasant population are more conservative than others. Industrialised society will have a complex class structure but in that the structure of subgroups will vary.

According to Almond and Powell, Political culture has three dimensions -

- 1) Cognitive orientation - It is meant recognition of political objects and events.
- 2) Affective orientation - It is meant feeling of attachment and rejection about a particular political object
- 3) Evaluative orientation - It is meant application of judgements and opinions of political objectives and events.
