



1. (a) Alternative sources of *energy and energy conservation measures:*

Kharagpur College has a 20 KW grid connected roof top solar photovoltaic plant is installed with the financial support of Government of west Bengal under Aloshree Prakalpa on the roof of administrative building. The solar power has been converted into AC power and that is connected with the state electricity power grid which will reduce the burden of college electricity bill.




A 20 KW grid connected roof top solar photovoltaic plant is installed with the financial support of Government of west Bengal under Aloshree Prakalpa

The college has been very conscious always about the energy consumption issue. Accordingly, the normal light bulbs and tubes (high wattage) are replaced by energy efficient bulbs e.g. CFLs, LEDs and slim lights. The college has also replaced all the CRT monitors by LCD/LED monitors. Thus, the objective of using power efficient equipment is fulfilled. Students are made aware of the necessity of saving electricity and water through digital display board and posters at different corners of the college.

(b) Management of the various types of degradable and non-degradable waste Solid waste management:

Coloured dustbins are used to collect the solid waste in segregated form. This ass then subsequently collected by the local Municipality from the college campus.

- The Green-colored dustbins are used for wet and biodegradable wastes.
- Blue dustbins are used for disposal of plastic wrappers and non-biodegradable wastes.
- Yellow dustbins are meant for papers and glass bottles.

The entire campus is a "plastic free zone" and the institution sincerely puts efforts to maintain the same. Portion of the Biodegradable waste is used as manure for the plants in the garden.

Liquid waste management:

Liquid chemical waste products produced from the laboratories are treated before disposal. As a routine practice, chemical wastes are segregated as acids and bases.

Biomedical waste management:

A vermicomposting unit has been developed by the college for decomposition of domestic waste of the college Boys' hostel and bio wasted materials of the campus. As a routine biomedical waste management process in the college, the animal anatomical waste material collected in yellow bags is disposed of in a deep burial pit constructed within the college campus. This is equally true for the used syringe and the cotton applied for blood collection.

Hazardous waste management:

Practices adopted for management of hazardous chemical wastes generated in laboratories. Chemical wastes are separated into different groups and disposed accordingly.

E-Waste management:

A service agreement for E-waste management is signed with Hulladek Recycling Private Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Act 2013; to pick up, transport, carry and recycle/dispose of the E-waste from the Kharagpur College time to time. They also provided an e-waste dustbin in the college campus for the collection of e-wastes.









2. Water conservation

3. Rain water harvesting:

A big pond of nearly 4800 sq metre is situated at the centre of the college campus. It is the main of our rain water harvesting process. The water of the pond is used for non-drinking purpose such as for the watering of trees, construction and other repairing work of the building etc. In addition, the college has also built a rain water harvesting unit using the rooftop rain water of Vidyasagar Bhavan. This water is utilised for two purposes. Firstly, it is used in ladies toilet and the excess amount of water is meant for re-charging the ground water.

4. Bore well/ open well recharge:

Huge area in our college campus is covered by soil. Naturally, there is no dearth of ground water reserve in the college campus. This stock of ground water is used mainly for drinking purpose. Thus, the institution seeks to reduce the practice of consuming ground water for regular activities and contributes to the preservation of ground water resources to a certain extent.
