- Online teaching learning process to be continued till offline classes started; adhering to the academic calendar of the affiliating university, and study materials were regularly uploaded in the college webpage for the benefit of the students, especially for those who could not regularly attend online classes due to very poor internet connectivity in their localities. For quality improvement of the teaching learning process students' feedback on teachers' performance were taken after completion of the last internal assessment, and communicated to the concerned teachers by the Principal himself.
