Now, I take this opportunity to place before you the round-up events occurred during the last one year since we celebrated our 70th year of the establishment of the college.

During this period, our colleagues Sri Ramananda Sahu, Accountant and Sri Sunil Chalak, Sweeper, retired from their service. We express our gratitude and sincere regards to all of them for their invaluable services rendered to this institution.

We feel pain to report that during this period we have lost our respected ex-colleagues, Prof. Asok Mukhopadhyay, former Head of Bengali and an ex-student of our college and Prof. Juran Krishna Sarkhel, ex-president of the Governing Body of this college. We convey our heart-felt feelings to their bereaved family members and pray to the almighty that their departed souls may rest in peace.

It is my pleasure to mention that our College has received an amount of Rupees one crore under RUSA 2.0 infrastructural grant by the Rastriya Uchhatara Siksha Avijan (RUSA) for new construction, renovation and procurement of equipment, books, computer and printers during the current financial year 2018-19. New equipment, computers, printers, books have been procured from this grant. Extension of the Computer Science Building has started. Vertical extension of the Z Building will be started soon. Construction of another new building is upcoming.

A New building named 'Vidyasagar Bhavana" has been inaugurated by sri Suvendu adhikari, Honourable minister of Transport, Government of West Bengal on 10th August - 2019 in presence of Honorable Vice Chancellor Prof Ranjan Chakraborty and Joint Secretary Shri Hari Sadhan Das, Govt of West Bengal. This

building is constructed with the financial support of Rupees One Crore from the Higher Education Department, Govt of West Bengal. The Grant was sanctioned on our appeal to the Hon'ble Chief Minister when she came to our campus in 2017.

I am happy to tell you that our former Principal, Dr. Nilay Kumar Banerjee donated 30 valuable books on different subjects to our college library.

As per recommendation of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of this college, all the departments have started semester wise mentoring and counselling of each Hons student as per NAAC guidelines. Parent-Teachers meeting also started in all departments from the last academic session.

Now, I like to address the research and academic activities of the teachers of different departments in the last one year.

i) Dr. Sukla Mondal Saha, Associate Professor, Dept of Economics achieved the PhD degree from Vidyasagar on 6th February-2019.

ii) Dr. Rakhal Chandra Bhunia, Assistant Professor, Dept of History was also awarded the PhD degree of from VidyaSagar University on 15th May - 2019.

iii) Dr. Ganesh Tosh of Sanskrit Department also received the PhD degree from Chaudhury Charan Singh University, Meerat on 22nd May this year.

- One day National Seminar on "Premchand: Katha Sahitya Ke Bibidha Ayam", organised by Dept of Hindi, Kharagpur College, held on 09th August, 2019.
- A Student Induction Programme was organised by the IQAC of this college on 10th August to make the students aware about the activities of four cells : Career Counseling Cell, Grievance & Redressal Cell, Women cell and Anti ragging cell of this college.
- Department of Philosophy celebrated "Indian Philosopher's Day 2019" on 14th August with the financial support of Indian Council of Philosophical Research, New Delhi.

Major Project:

• A major project funded by Board of Research in Nuclear Sciences (BRNS) is completed under the principal investigator Dr. Jyotirmoy Pramanik, Associate Professor in Physics to study the Characterization of Particle growth and stable dust structures in a cogenerated dusty plasma during 2016-19.

Career Counselling and Placement Cell:

Regarding campus Placement our college performed a good record of job oriented training and placement opportunities in the college campus since 2013. In the last one year it got momentum.

In September-2018, one International BPO company visited our college and selected 8 passed out students of BA, BSc and Bcom for recruitment.

In October last year, during Puja vacation Tata Consultancy service provided 21 days Training programme for career development in corporate sector. 46 students of BA, BSc, BCom and MA completed the programme and 7 students were recruited in the Regional Head Office of TCS at Newtown.
