On this auspicious occasion, we have arranged a programme to commemorate this unforgettable event with all our well-wishers, faculties, non-teaching staff and students with passion and solemnity. It is of great pleasure to me to extend a very warm and hearty welcome on behalf of the college to all those present in this auspicious function. I solemnly remember with high regards, Prof.H.B.Sarkar, the Founder Principal of this college, and, also, all other honorable persons, who contributed selflessly towards development of this institution in different capacities at different times. We are grateful to Prof.(Dr.) Tapan Kumar Pal, WBSCHE nominee of the Governing Body of our college, an Educationalist and Social Worker to preside over the programme. He is an Honourable member of our Alumni Association and is also an Ex-Faculty Member of our Mathematics Department and Ex-Head of the Mathematics Department of Vidyasagar University. He is always with us and Kharagpur College will be always grateful to you sir.

New equipment, computers, printers, books have been procured from this grant.

Construction of a new building named "Vivekananda Bhavana" and vertical extension of two classroom buildings have been completed with the financial support of RUSA 2.0 grant.

Also; Construction of first floor of the existing central Library building is completed with the financial support of Government of West Bengal.

During this period, our colleagues Prof. Sukla Roy, Associate Professor, Deptt of Philosophy, Dr.Anjan Bagchi, Associate Professor, Dept of Political Science and Dr. Achintya Chattopadhyaya, Associate Professor, Deptt. of Bengali retired from their service. During this period, our colleagues Sri Subhas Chandra De, Skilled Lab Attendant, Sri Sambhunath Rana, Skilled Lab Attendant, Dept. of Physics, Smt. G. Sakuntala, Bearer retired from their service. We express our gratitude and sincere regards to all of them for their invaluable services rendered to this institution. We feel pain to report that during this period we have lost our respected ex colleagues, Prof. Swapan Kumar Laha of Commerce Department and Prof. Samiresh Dasgupta, former Head of the Deptt. Of Bengali, Prof. Goutam Neogi of History department and Sri Ajoy Nandi, Laboratory staff of Botany Department. We convey our heart-felt feelings to their bereaved family members and pray to the almighty that their departed souls may rest in peace.

Now, I would like to address the research and academic activities of the teachers of different departments in the last one year.

i) Prof. Debasish Aich, Assistant Professor, Dept of Physics is awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) from Vidyasagar University.

ii) Prof. Mintu Naskar, Assistant Professor, Dept of Bengali also got the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) from VidyaSagar University.

iii) Prof. Poulomi Talukdar, Assistant Professor, Dept of Philosophy is awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy from Jadavpur University.

iv) Sri Sudhangsu Barman, SACT, Dept of Political Science is also awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy from CMJ University, Meghalaya.

- A certificate course on Green Audit has been organized by the college on and from 13.06.2022. 25 students completed this course.
- Another certificate course on Yoga has been organized by the college on and from 10.06.2022. 50 students registered in this course.
- An Online Awareness programme on Intellectual Property Right (IPR) among the students of Kharagpur College was organised by the Department for Promotion of industry & Internal Trade under Ministry of Commerce & Industry (DPIIT) & Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Kharagpur College on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2022.
- As per recommendation of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of this college, all the departments conducted semester wise mentoring and counselling of each Hons student as per NAAC guidelines. Parent -

teachers meetings were also conducted in all departments in this academic session.

• All the promotion related documents of nineteen teachers have been verified by the IQAC and selection/screening committee meeting held on 25.06.2022 at Vidyasagar University and relevant fixation proposals have been submitted to the DPI.

All the departments have successfully conducted the Mentor-Mentee programmes throughout the year. Each and every student of our college now has a mentor and our teachers are nourishing the young minds of our college with great care. Mentoring and Students seminar are now regular phenomena in our college. And these two phenomena have made the bonding between the students and our teachers stronger. The college also cares the student's feedback which is now become a regular practice.

Health Department of the Govt. of West Bengal has administered both  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  dose of vaccine to the students of our college. Our college was able to set up a Medical unit in the campus for periodic checkup of health of our stakeholders.
