- Impacts on mental health.

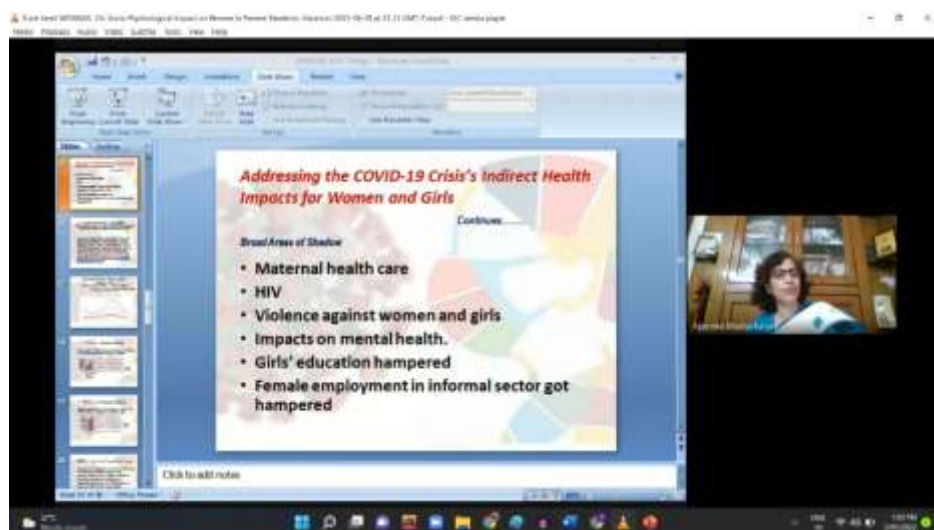
She discussed all these issues in detail and offered a valuable solution.
